SECTION TWO: Event Information

2.1 Event Details

The 2012 Victorian Country Interdistrict will be held at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre on Saturday 25 February 2012.

2.2 Program of Events

The 2012 Victorian Country Interdistrict will consist of 64 events conducted over 1 session.

2.2.1 Warm Up and Competition Times

Warm up finishes 10 minutes prior to the competition start time.

Indoor Pool

- During sessions, 4 lanes in the indoor 50m Pool will be available

2.3 Qualifying Times

Do not apply to this meet.

2.4 Entry Process

Entries for the 2012 Victorian Country Interdistrict will open on Wednesday 27 January. Entries will close at 5:00pm on Monday 13 February.

- **Entry is via District Only.** All entries must be lodged via Meet Manager or Team Manager only. MM and TM files available at www.swimmingvictoria.org.au.
- \$5 per individual event, \$13 per relay event
- All entries must be lodged via email to events@vic.swimming.org.au.
- There is no requirement for a hard copy of entries or paperwork to be submitted.
- All entries and paperwork can be submitted via email only. Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- **Districts will be invoiced for entry fees. Please do not pay in any other format.**

2.5 Conditions of Entry

[Swimming Victoria By-Laws](#) apply. These By-Laws stipulate that refunds are not provided unless an entry is rejected. Refunds are not provided for any other reason; including medical grounds. An event will not be conducted if less than four nominations are received for that event. Swimmers are restricted to events in their own age group. Each District can provide only one swimmer event and one relay team per relay event.

2.6 Relays

Open relays are 'open' to all ages. The Sovereign Hill Trophy will be awarded to the District gaining the most points for the four 'open' relays.

2.7 Parking

SV recommends the use of public transport to travel to and from the MSAC.

If required, paid parking is available in the lakeside car park which is located off Aughtie Drive. For further information please visit the MSAC website www.msac.com.au.

2.8 Warm Up Procedures

Warm-up in competition pool will cease 10 mins prior to start of session. Please follow lane signage during warm up periods. During sessions, there will be 4 lanes in the indoor 50m Pool available.

2.9 Results

Lives results will be posted on the Swimming Victoria website www.swimmingvictoria.org.au. During the event results will also be posted on the second level of the outdoor pool behind the grandstand.

2.10 Ticketing

2.11 Team Managers

Each District is entitled to two Team Managers. The name and an address for these Team Managers must be emailed to events@vic.swimming.org.au by Monday 13 February 2012. All Team Managers will be entitled to free entry to the venue. Passes will be sent in the mail in the week prior to the event to the nominated Team Manager's address.

2.12 Programs

2.13 Timekeepers

Each District is to supply 3 timekeepers for the duration of the meet; this is in addition to those officials who are on the roster for other positions (i.e. Referees, starters, etc). A roster for timekeepers will be published in the lead up to the event.

2.14 Lost Property

At the conclusion of each session, all property left on seats will be removed from the grandstand and handed in to the MSAC reception.
